Proposal - Clarification of 4.5 Seeding

Dear delegates of the session 2019,
on behalf of the technical commission I would like to propose the following changes of the organization and sporting code: 4.5 Seeding:

Change:

On Ranking Events, ~~World Championships~~, the seeding is made by the use of the official JJIF ranking list, as defined in Section 7.

Remove

~~If one of the athletes is not present, his seeding position will be included in the random draw.~~

Add:

If one of the athletes is not present, the next highest ranked person, who is present in the event, will get the seeding position. This procedure stops at the ranking position No 10 for World Championships and at seeding position no 20 for continental championship and rother ranking events.

Footnote: f.e. if the second highest ranked player does not participate in an event. The third highest ranked (if present) will be placed on the seeding position number 2, the next highest athletes present to position no 3 and so on. If none of the top 20 ranked athletes is present the position will be included in the random draw.

The technical commission realized that the usage of the current seeding system was not fair and wanted to clarify the procedure.
